Haggai 1-2

1. Dan shared the story of teens in Afghanistan and J.Christy Wilson's cemetery tour. One man labored for 30 years with no converts. One for 25 years to baptize the first Christian. Now the teens bring in part of the harvest. What do you think of that story? Do you know others like it? Does it encourage or discourage you?

2. When it comes to God's work in our community, do you tend to think... "This is the way it's always been and the way it will always be..." or "It's never going to be as good as it was back then..." or "these are the greatest days to be a Christian..." Regardless can you relate to the people of Haggai's day?

3. Read Haggai 2:7-9, 2 Chronicles 7:1-2, John 1:14, 1 Corinthians 3:16, 2 Corinthians 3:18, and Romans 8:18-19. What principles about God, the Kingdom of God, and our mission do you learn from those scriptures? How might you respond, lean into God's Word in these verses?

4. Read Haggai 1:2-4. Do you think God's House, the church today, lies in ruins? Why or why not?

5. As you read Haggai what principles related to stuff and money might we learn?

6. When you "consider your ways" what are the ways that concern you the most?

7. Which of the three prayer requests do you feel the need to focus in on most?
