

**LifeGroup Discussion Questions**  
**Life's Too Short to Die Rich**  
**Luke 12:13-34**

1. In the beginning of the message, Dan talked about happiness. Describe a time/season of life when you have been happy, when it had little to do with how much stuff you had.
  
2. If there is a God-Dream for you to pursue (like there is an American-Dream) what are some of the elements of your God-dream life? What are you doing to pursue it?
  
3. Jesus challenges us in Luke 12:15 to guard against every kind of greed. What kind of greed do you wrestle with the most? Why? How do you guard against it? Describe a time when you felt most convicted about greed?
  
4. If greed is wanting more even at the detriment of others, in what ways could our “wanting more” hurt others? Is it fair to consider others around the world, rather than just others in our community?
  
5. Why is it so easy for us to think that more stuff = more life?
  
6. Luke 12:20 give the epitaph for the successful business person of Jesus’ story. Why is it so difficult to be stuff-rich and have a rich relationship with God?
  
7. Luke 12:34 give us the treasure principle. “Where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.” What/who is your treasure? What would it look like if Christ was treasured in our hearts above everything else?
  
8. How is God calling you to lean in to treasuring Christ?
