

**LifeGroup Questions**  
**Take a Step #3 -- I Timothy 6:6-19**

1. Dan shared the story about Jerry's generosity adventure in Moscow and then said, "The goal that generosity is chasing is the shaping of Jesus in our hearts and the revelation of Jesus to the world." What do you think about that as a mission statement for generosity?
2. I Timothy 6:6-9 sets up the tension between contentment and a long to be rich? In what areas is contentment easy or difficult for you? When/if we long to be rich, what drives that longing?
3. Dan talked about the longing to be rich being driven by shame (status anxiety), living for the here and now vs heaven, and embracing the myth of more. Which one of those do you wrestle with most?
4. Read I Timothy 6:9-10, which of the descriptions of what can happen when we love/crave money concerns you the most? Which, if any, have you experienced?
5. Read I Timothy 6:17-19, Paul paints a picture of living a generosity-Kingdom dream. In order to live this dream we need to, trust a better savior, live entrusted not entitled, and grab life through generosity. Which one of those do you need to dive into the most?
6. What does it look like in your life to be rich in good deeds, generous to share and quick to help those in need?
7. Don't miss the fact that Paul has no problem saying that when it comes to generosity, there is something in it for you – storing up treasure, laying a strong foundation, grabbing life – what do you think about that? A promise of reward for generosity?
8. Where is God calling you to lean in to this teaching on generosity?

9. What question/concerns do you have so far from any of the teaching on generosity?
