1. Dan started with a few “bad neighbor” stories. Do you have a “bad neighbor” story? Or perhaps even a time when you were a bad neighbor?
  
2. What are some of the barriers, issues, or difficulties you have with our front-yard mission strategy at Calvary? What makes it difficult to love your neighbor?
  
3. Read Matthew 22:35-40. Describe your standard of loving when you try to love your neighbor like you love yourself? Looking at I Corinthians 13:4-7, when it comes to loving your neighbor, what qualities of “loving” listed here, do you score high on...and which do you score low on?
  
4. Dan focused on the expectancy of love. Love always hopes. Do you see your neighbors, your co-workers, your classmates with eyes of expectancy? What makes it difficult to be hopeful about others?
  
5. Read Romans 8:18-26. We groan with hope. Expectancy turns our groans into hopeful intercession. Are you...or have you experienced that kind of expectancy with your front-yard mission? With your neighbors? With people at work? What impacts you the most from this scripture passage?
  
6. Read Romans 8:32-39. Do you truly believe these words? What in this passage is most encouraging? What do you doubt the most? If you truly believe these words, how will that shape the way you love your neighbors?
  
7. What questions do you have about front-yard missions at Calvary?
